
FROM 70-TON PLATE B RBOX TO 100-TON PLATE C MRL by David G. Casdorph

(Below) MRL 21038 was rebuilt in March 1993 at the Livingston Rebuild Center. The car is part of a series of 250 cars numbered MRL 21001-21250. Rebuilding includes raising the roof and increasing the inside height by four inches, new sliding door, 100-ton trucks (the cars originally had 70-ton trucks), and adding 15" end-of-car cushioning (original cars were uncushioned). The cars started as RBOX 14000-series box cars. They then went to the Southern 14000- series when the initial RBOX dispersion occured in 1983. Last year 250 of those went to the Montana Rail Link's 14000-series. As the cars are rebuilt they are being placed into the new MRL 21001-21250 series.





(Above) A 3/4 view of the end shows how the roof was raised just above the posts. The inside height was raised four inches. (Below) Side view to right of door showing markings and continued channel above posts. Note also that the door opening height was also increased by four inches.




























